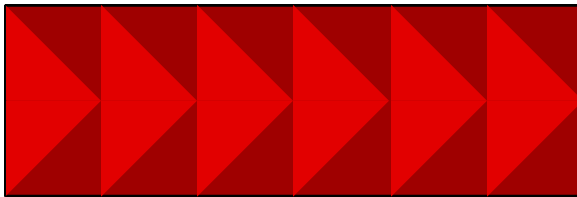

NOTE: As this has a template, please be sure you print actual size or 100%.

DO NOT Shrink to Fit or reduce.

<i>Yardage</i>	Finishes 60" x 10"
	<u>Background</u> $\frac{2}{3}$ yard (or 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ "")
	<u>Pink</u> $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
	<u>Red</u> $\frac{1}{3}$ yard
	<u>White</u> $\frac{1}{3}$ yard
	Fusible Web 3 yards
Yardage is from width of fabric (42"-44"). Seams are sewn $\frac{1}{4}$ ".	



Cutting the Fabrics

If you are using fusible web, add the fusible to the back of all fabrics. Leave the paper backing on as you cut and sew.

From your Pink fabric, cut as follows:

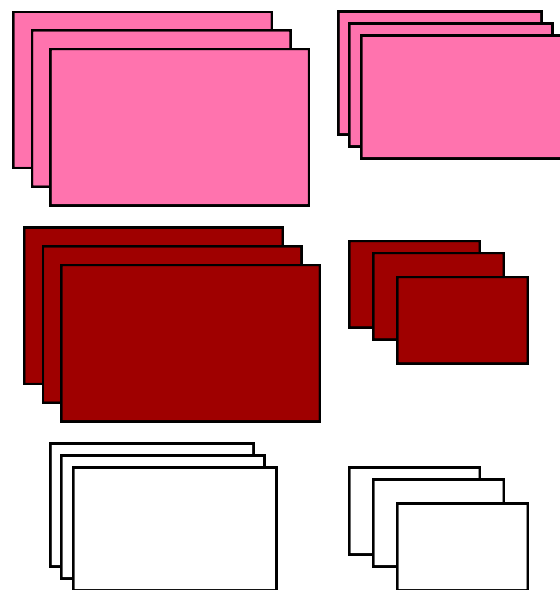
- 1 – 8 ¼" strip, then 8 – 5" segments ("Pink Large")
- 2 – 3 ½" strips, then 8 – 6 ½" segments ("Pink Medium")

From your Red fabric, cut as follows:

- 1 – 8 ¼" strip, then 8 – 5" segments ("Red Large")
- 1 – 2 ½" strip, then 8 – 4" segments ("Red Small")

From your White fabric, cut as follows:

- 2 – 3 ½" strips, then 8 – 6 ½" segments ("White Medium")
- 1 – 2 ½" strip, then 8 – 4" segments ("White Small")

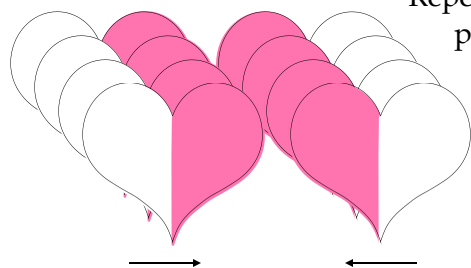
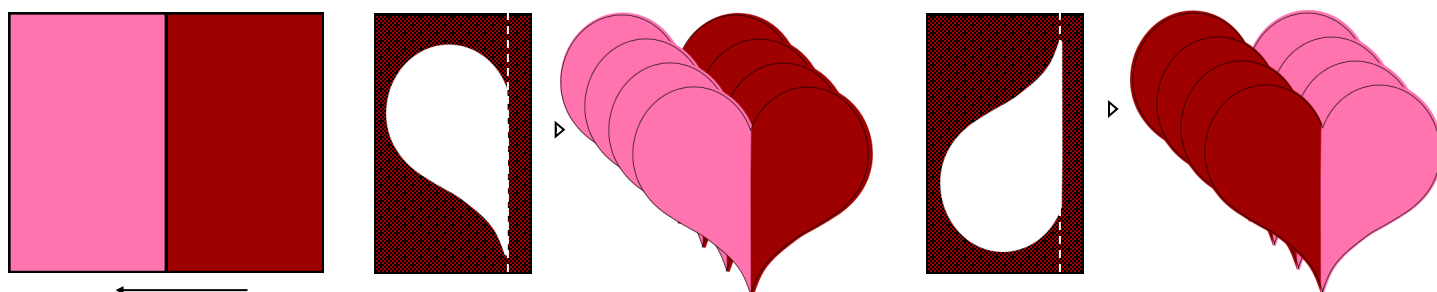


Making the Hearts

Create three half heart templates from the diagram on the last page. Create a Large, Medium, and Small.

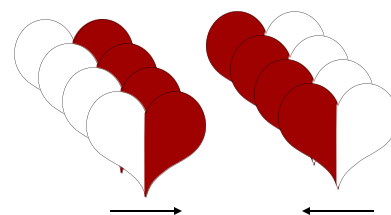
Sew together a Pink Large segment and Red Large segment along the long sides so the Pink is on the left. Finger press the seams to the Pink. With the sewn segment right sides together, place the Large heart template up against the seam, trace the shape and cut out a two-colored heart. Repeat for four hearts. Remove any dog ears that are visible from the front of the heart.

Then flip the heart template around and cut out another four. This changes the placement of the fabrics.



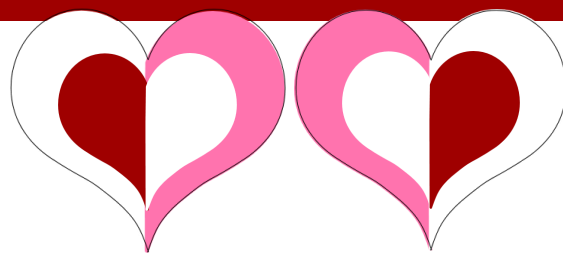
Repeat the process with the White Medium and Pink Medium (finger pressing the seams to the Pink) and make four of each.

Then repeat again with the White Small and Red Small (finger pressing the seams to the Red) and make four of each.

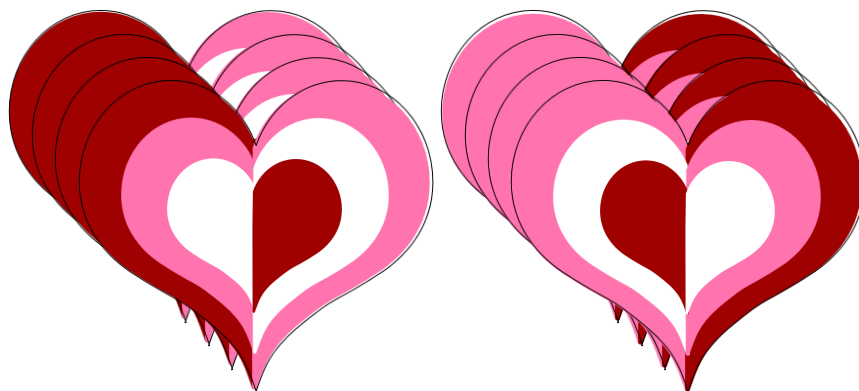


Making the Hearts (continued)

Remove the fusible paper backing from the Small hearts. Position a Small heart on the Medium heart as pictured to the right and press to fuse in place. (Notice there are two different color arrangements.)



Then remove the paper backing from the Medium and place on the Large heart as pictured. Press to fuse in place.



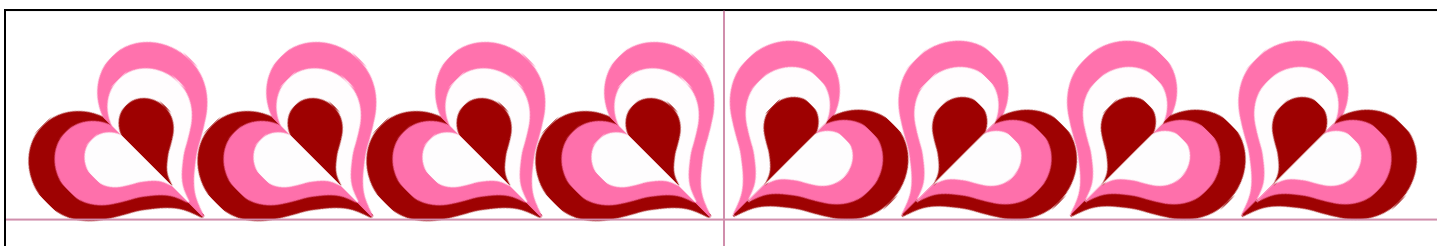
Make four of each for a total of eight hearts.

Putting the Row Together

Cut and/or piece your background fabric $10\frac{1}{2}$ " tall by $60\frac{1}{2}$ " wide. The easiest way to do this is to cut, then piece two segments $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $30\frac{1}{2}$ ". (This will also automatically give you a center vertical seam.) For placement guides, draw a faint removable line (or create a crease) by folding at the center of the background and $1\frac{3}{4}$ " from the bottom. Remove the paper backing from the large hearts. Now it is time for final layout.

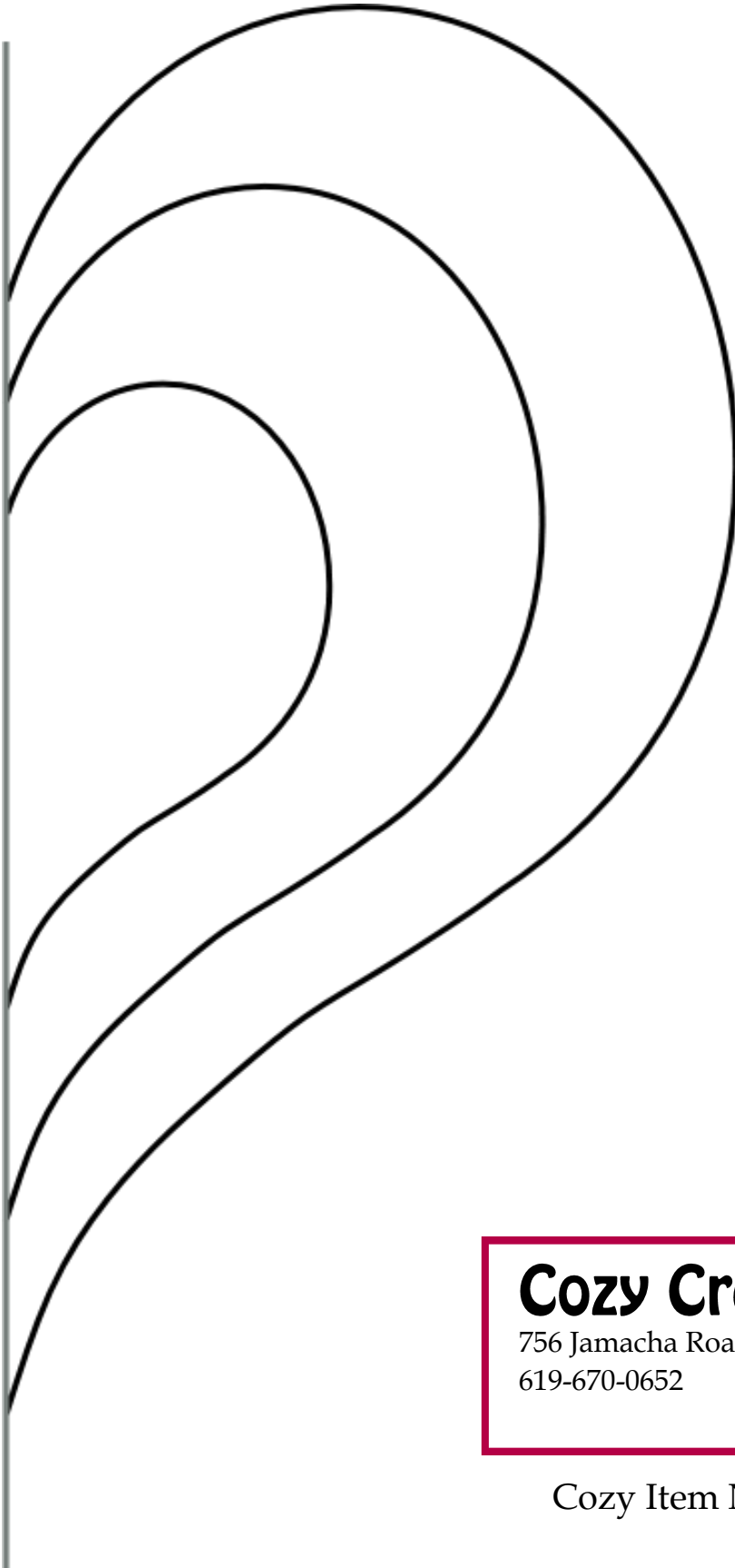


Notice that you created two different hearts: one with Red Large on the left and another with Red Large on the right. Arrange the hearts as pictured below so that the hearts with the Red on the left are on the left of the center line and the ones with the Red on the right are on the right. Use the $1\frac{3}{4}$ " horizontal guide to line up the points and the Red part of the heart. If it helps for placement, the heart is angled 45° . Lay out your hearts in a pleasing manner, then fuse in place.



Finish by stitching them in place. Since the hearts are so close together, you might want to stitch them in place with invisible thread just inside of the heart edge.
