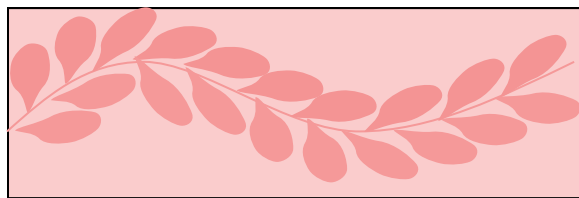
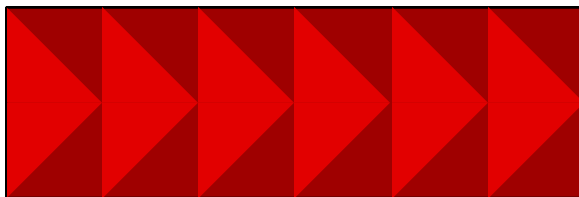

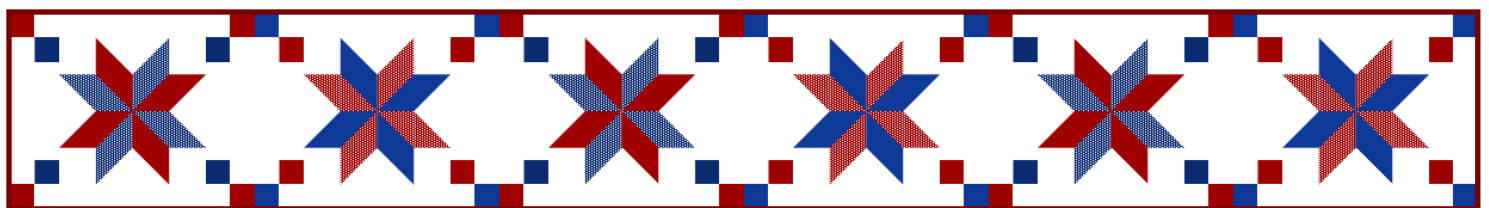

<i>Yardage</i>	Finishes 8" x 60"
	<b>Background</b> 5/8 yard
	<b>Red 1</b> 1/8 yard
	<b>Blue 1</b> 1/8 yard
	<b>Red 2</b> 1/8 yard
	<b>Blue 2</b> 1/8 yard
Yardage is from width of fabric (42"-44"). Strips are cut from width of fabric. Seams are sewn 1/4".	



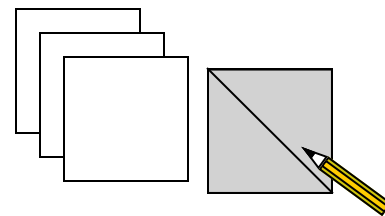
# Cutting the Fabrics

Cut your Background Fabric as follows:

4 – 2" strips. Then cut those strips into 72 – 2" squares.

On the back of 48 squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.

(Note: the shaded graphic signifies the back)

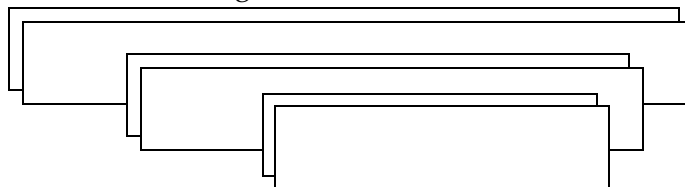


7 – 1 1/2" strips. Then cut those strips into the following:

12 – 8 1/2" segments

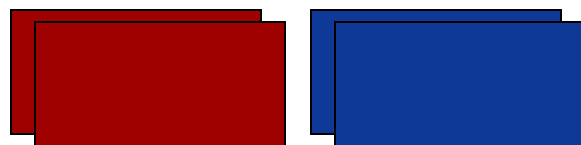
12 – 6 1/2" segments

12 – 4 1/2" segments



Red 1 and Blue 1 are identical, so cut each as follows:

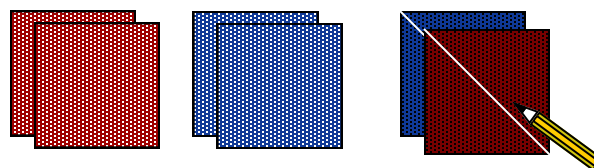
2 – 2" strips. Then cut those strips into 12 – 3 1/2" segments.



Red 2 and Blue 2 are identical, so cut each as follows:

2 – 2" strips. Then cut those strips into 24 – 2" squares.

On the back of 12 squares of each color, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.



From leftover fabric, cut the following:

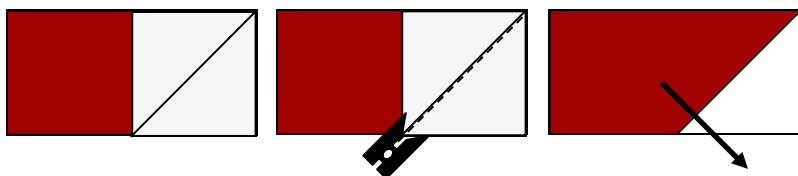
24 – 1 1/2" squares from Red (Red 1 and/or Red 2)

24 – 1 1/2" squares from Blue (Blue 1 and/or Blue 2).

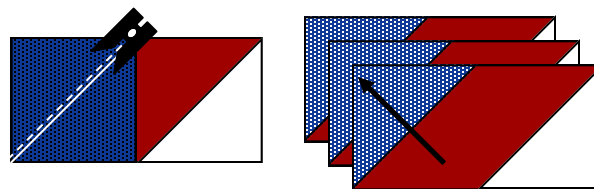


# Making the Block

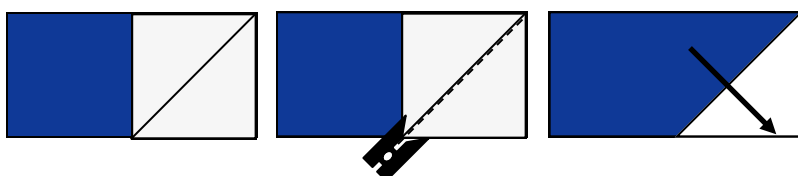
Place a background square (with a diagonal line) right sides together on a Red 1 rectangle as pictured. Stitch a thread inside the drawn line (toward the outer point). Flip the fabric over and be sure it neatly goes to the point. If it does, you can cut away the excess fabric behind the background. Press as indicated.



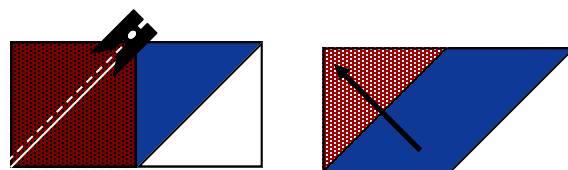
Repeat with a Blue 2 square on the other side as pictured. Make 12 segments as pictured.



Repeat the same technique putting a background square (with a diagonal line) right sides together on a Blue 1 rectangle. Then adding a Red 2 square to the other side.

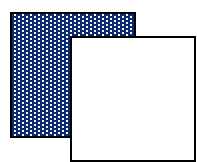


Make 12 segments as pictured.

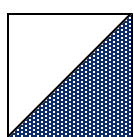
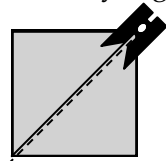


## Making the Block (continued)

Collect the 2" background squares (with diagonal lines) and the 2" Blue 2 squares and 2" Red 2 squares.

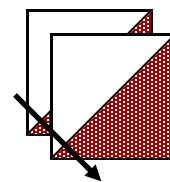
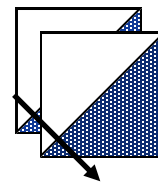


Place the background square right sides together on a Blue 2 square as pictured. Stitch a thread inside the drawn line (toward an outer point). Flip the fabric over and be sure it neatly goes to the point. Cut away the excess fabric behind the background.

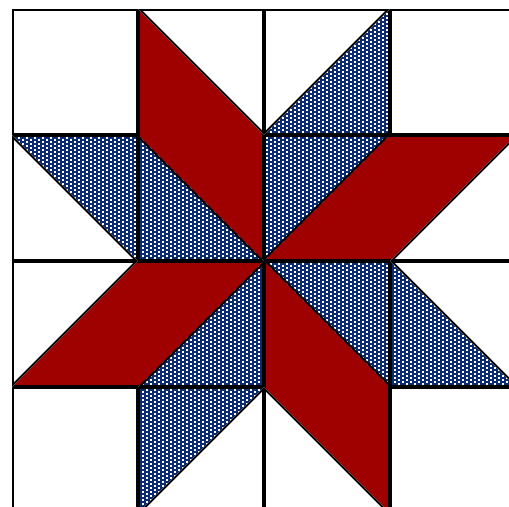
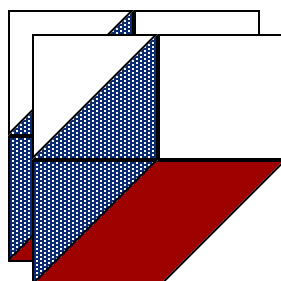
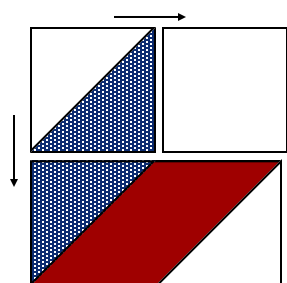


Press as indicated.

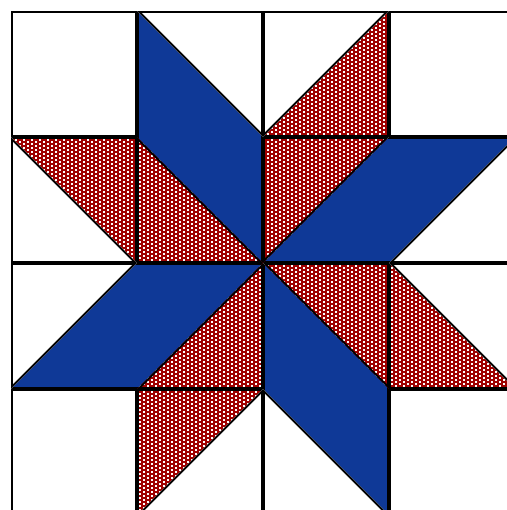
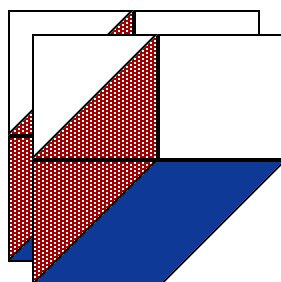
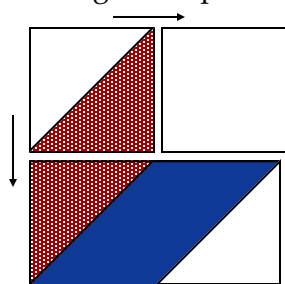
Make 12 pieced squares with Blue 2, and 12 pieced squares with Red 2.



There are two blocks and each block is assembled with 4 like quadrants. Here is the quadrant for Block 1 (with Red 1 and Blue 2). Sew the pieces together to make 12 quadrants. Then sew the quadrants together to complete Block 1. Make 3 Block 1's measuring 6 1/2" square.



Here is the quadrant for Block 2 (with Blue 1 and Red 2). Sew the pieces together to make 12 quadrants. Then sew the quadrants together to complete Block 2. Make 3 Block 2's measuring 6 1/2" square.



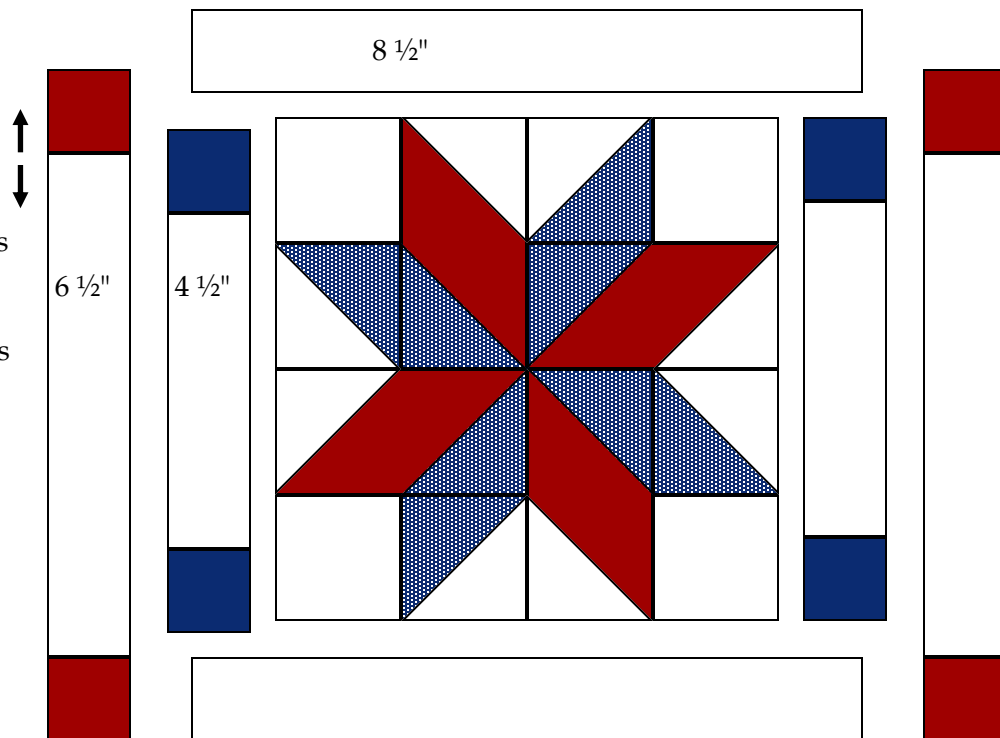
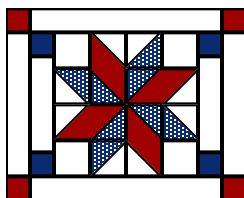
# Complete the Blocks

To each block add the remaining background segments and cornerstones\* as pictured.

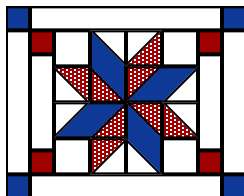
\*For Block 1, use Blue cornerstones with the inner segments and Red cornerstones with the outer segments.

For Block 2, use Red cornerstones with the inner segments and Blue cornerstones with the outer segments.

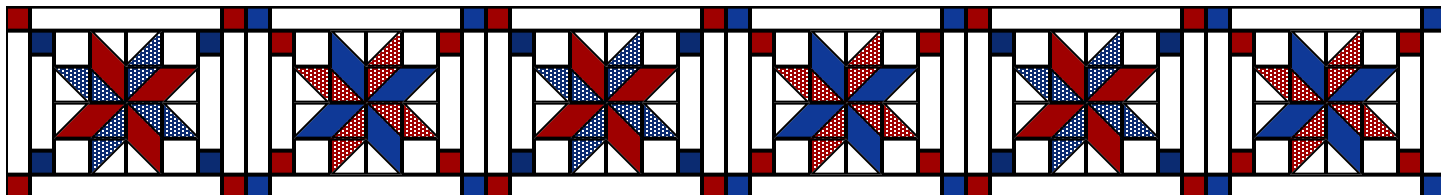
Complete 3 Block 1's, measuring 10 1/2" wide, by 8 1/2" tall.



Complete 3 Block 2's, measuring 10 1/2" wide, by 8 1/2" tall



Then alternate your blocks to complete your row!
