| <b>Also GREAT with Fat Quarters!</b>  |                                |                       |                         |                        |                         |                          |
| *What if you don't have strips yet? Cut strips from quarter-yard cuts (3 from each) or half strips from fat quarters (7 from each). <i>The Wall Hanging recommendation is padded for variety.</i> |                                |                       |                         |                        |                         |                          |
| <b>Quarter-yard Cuts</b>  | 4                              | 4                     | 6                       | 7                      | 9                       | 14                       |
| <b>Fat Quarters</b>   | 4                              | 4                     | 5                       | 6                      | 8                       | 12                       |
| <b>Half Strips</b>  |                                |                       |                         |                        |                         |                          |
| *And if you are working through scraps? Your print strips need to be a minimum of 2 1/2" x 20" of workable fabric which is the equivalent of a "half strip." | <b>Half Strips</b>  | 8                              | 24                    | 33                      | 42                     | 54                      | 79                       |

Yardage based on at least 40" wide of workable fabric. All seams are 1/4".
