

SewQuester Mystery Quilt 2020

Step 2– Cutting Your Block Fabrics



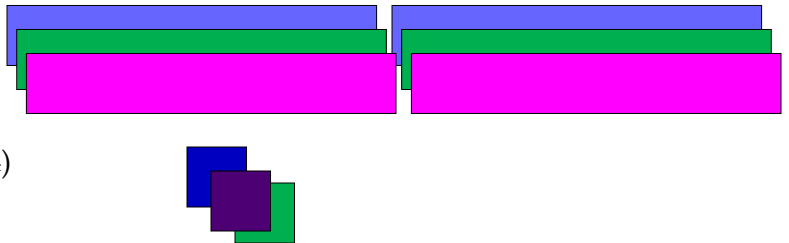
Strips

If you don't already have your strips, cut them now from width of fabric. *If you are using fat quarters, cut your half strips from the length of the fat quarter so they measure at least 20" long.*

You need 4 – 2 ½" print strips for the Wall Hanging (12 for the Lap, 17 for the Throw, 21 for the Twin, 27 for the Queen, 40 for the King).

Cut each in half on the fold for a total of 8 half strips (24, 33, 42, 54, 79).

Then cut 2 half strips (6, 8, 10, 13, 18) into 16 – 2 ½" squares (48, 64, 80, 100, 144) and set aside for Block A.



Instructions given are for the Wall Hanging. Other sizes are in parenthesis (Lap, Throw, Twin, Queen, King).

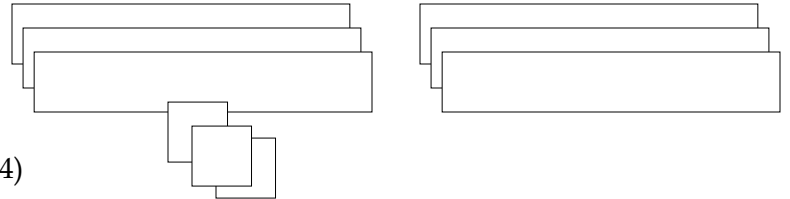
Background

4 – 2 ½" strips (12, 17, 21, 27, 40).

Then cut in half for 8 half strips (24, 33, 42, 54, 79).

From 2 half strips (6, 8, 10, 13, 18) cut 16 – 2 ½" squares (48, 64, 80, 100, 144)

Set the squares aside for the Block A.



5 – 2" strips (13, 18, 22, 27, 39).

Then cut 16 – 9 ½" segments (48, 64, 80, 100, 144) and set aside for the sashing.

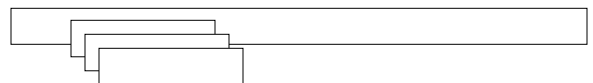
Then cut 4 – 2" squares (17, 24, 31, 40, 60) and set those aside for the cornerstones.



TIP: if you think you might be shy on background, you can skip this step for now. You can always choose a different fabric for sashing and cornerstones later!

3 – 1 ½" strips (9, 13, 16, 21, 31).

Then cut 20 – 4 ½" segments (72, 100, 128, 164, 244) and set aside for the block sashing.



Accent

1 – 1 ½" strip (1, 1, 2, 2, 3).

Then cut 5 – 1 ½" squares (18, 25, 32, 41, 61) and set aside for blockwork.
