






# Curvaceous Fabric Requirements

<b>Print Fat Quarters</b>	5	8	18	25	33

<b>Binding</b>	$\frac{1}{2}$ yard (6–2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips)	$\frac{1}{2}$ yard (6–2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips)	$\frac{2}{3}$ yard (9–2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips)	$\frac{3}{4}$ yard (10–2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips)	$\frac{7}{8}$ yard (11–2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips)

*Also helpful is the Cut A Round (Standard Size) by Phillips Fiber Art.*

*Fat Quarters should be at least 18" wide by 21" – 22"  
long of workable fabric. All seams are sewn  $\frac{1}{4}$ ".*

*\* Your accent fabrics give this pattern shape and should offer contrast to your fat quarters. We recommend using both light and dark prints. Also, because this pattern uses big pieces of fabric cut into circles, you only use a width of 30" of each accent fabric. Most quilt fabrics are 40" wide, so you will have 10" leftover from each accent fabric. You can use this in the border, in another quilt or in the backing.*
