

ROW, ROW, ROW YOUR QUILT!

This row quilt is a great way to use those neat border prints. You can also use theme prints that you just can't bear to cut into small pieces.

The yardage below is based on the quilt shown on the cover, using a directional themed border print. Of course, you may use any fabric of your choice!

Requirements

(A) Main Theme border print	1 3/8 yards
(B) Matching Theme coordinate	1/2 yard
(C) 4 Coordinating prints	1/4 yard ea.
(C1) & (C2) Rows 2 & 8 and scrappy rows	
(C3) & (C4) Sashing and scrappy rows	
(D) Outer border, middle and scrappy rows	1 1/4 yards
(E) Light coordinate for middle row, corner stones and scrappy row	1/2 yard
(F) Coordinate for sashing & scrappy row	1/2 yard
(G) Coordinate for inside border & scrappy row	3/8 yard
(H, I & J) Two or Three fat quarters of additional prints for the scrappy rows, or just pull some from your stash	
Backing	3 3/4 yards
Binding	5/8 yard
Batting	64"x76"
Stabilizer for the scrappy rows: 12" wide Golden Threads Quilting Paper, or Sulky Tear-Easy Lightweight Stabilizer	
Optional: Triangles On A Roll or Thangles: 4" finished block
