This design is stylish and elegant. The warm and striking colors complement the striped herringbone pattern. The Timtex interfacing gives it support.

Fabric Requirements

Main Fabric: Eight 1/4 yards or eight fat quarters in different colors or use 22" long strips in different colors that are left over from previous projects

Lining: 1 yard dark fabric

4 gold-tone decorative square rings

Timtex Interfacing: 1 3/8 yard (13" wide)

(Timtex is a sturdy interfacing that resembles compacted batting. It is lightweight and easy to sew through. It is ideal for shaping tote bags, fabric bowls, and similar products).

Batiks or fabric without any distinct pattern are the best choice for this project. Raid your stash or stock up on fat quarters. There is no limit to the number of colors you can use as long as they look good together. Rusts, dark greens, deep oranges, a touch of purple, brown, some yellow - just mix and match.

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
